These two colours have been presented at various times over the last few years, particularly the Steel which was among the first colours to be presented and its great news that it has at last gained its recognition.

The Sallender / Iron Grey was not accepted at this, its first appearance, but Im sure that Mel Stirr and other members will continue to campaign this lovely colour and it will appear in January 2010 at the Bradford.

If any member would like to join in these efforts to get more colours accepted for our breed, please get in touch with Jane Bramley. Presently we hope to present Sealpoint and some of the chocolate colours, including chocolate fox and otter,

chocolate self and possibly cinnamon.

Another possible set of colours are chinchilla and squirrel. Maybe you have others you would like to include? The criteria would be three rabbits each of three generations in the colour, hopefully proving progression.
