From the beginning..

This is a new feature I have decided to add to each Newsletter...This month I have asked Hollie James following her win at Emley YSS.









How I started..... I started with 2 pet mini lops.... having had rabbits since I was a tiny child these were the first 2 I bought myself living in my own house. No intention to breed and no idea whatsoever about 'showing' After working at a pet shop for a few years I decided to get a buck and breed some for the pet shop.... and well it escalated from there!

Hand up I started off thinking Lionlops were Lionhead x Lop (luckily I didn't try that mating before I found out how wrong it was!)

I got a lot of my stock originally from just other pet breeders who sadly I don't even know anymore.... added a few lines here and there and have what I like to think as half decent rabbits now, getting my very first BIS in August with a homebred baby!

I actually got into showing through angoras... which I no longer have.... I did it completely on my own and started off mostly lost and learning from my mistakes. But being me I ploughed on, made some friends and lost some along the way and hopefully still learning from my mistakes! (Don't put the rabbits in the runs the day before the show)

I'm a greedy breeder and couldn't decide between Lionheads, Lionlops and Minilops so I have all 3! My majority are Lionheads closely followed by Lionlops with just around 6 Minilops all in agouti pattern. Totalling 26 rabbits. 19 of which are all born and bred right here :) They are fed on Heygates and selective once a day in the evening with hay in the morning.

I keep them in 3'2 hutches with 4'2 for mums. All under a shelter I built myself, I prefer the shelter to a shed for the natural light and ventilation.

My favourite colours are Agouti, Steel and Chinchilla which is mainly what I have including the odd Red Eyed White that has popped out! I only have double maned rabbits in both Lionhead and Lionlops, love the fluff! I groom every single one once a day even if it's just a quick once over, I feel then at least I can keep on top of any changes.

At one point I had up to 48 rabbits at which point I decided to cut down, I felt it was too many for one person to handle and that they weren't getting all the attention they deserved. I'm happy with my number at the moment and hoping I can one day have a whole stud I can be proud of :) oh and full of winners!
